All rentals are for up to 5 hours, except for when an additional cocktail hour is also purchased for a total of 6. The rate also includes 2 hours of set-up time either the day of or the day before based on availability.

All rentals are inclusive of equipment that the theatre owns and is not already in use for a show or previously planned event. Items include but are not limited to; tables and chairs, dance floor, theatrical lighting, up-lighting, PA and sound equipment, LCD Projector, screen, staging, piano (tuning additional cost), red carpet, snow machines and other various production equipment. Stage hand labor will be billed additionally as needed and are required for all main stage events. Estimates will be given beforehand.

The Acopian Room



Above the theatre is the grand ballroom, named for Sarkis Acopian, whose family's contribution to the theatre allowed for complete renovation of this magnificent space.

Offering a full catering kitchen adjacent to the hall, the area is private, yet easily accessible via stairs through the main lobby or by elevator through the Administrative Hall.

Restrooms and a coat check area are convenient, and a grand balcony offers a special area to tuck away a DJ or make your announcements.

The Ballroom will accommodate up to 140 seated with a dance floor, up to 200 without, and up to 300 standing. A portable dance floor and standard sound system are included, if needed. This is a popular spot for meetings, lectures and employee gatherings that require projection and sound.

The Mezzanine



The breathtaking decor and soaring visuals will make your Mezzanine/Lobby reception a memorable one.

If the classic feel of the opulence and drama of the theatre is what you are looking for, this two-level reception area is perfect for your needs. Boasting two built-in bars and convenient rest rooms, this is the ideal location for a cocktail reception with limited seating needs.

Accommodating 100 - 150 people, the area is accessed through the main lobby of the theatre. The upper level, or Mezzanine, overlooks the main Lobby which has been fully restored to its original grandeur.

The lower level also boasts handicap comfort facilities.

Flanked by stairs, the area lends itself to wonderful photo opportunities and smooth traffic flow for your guests.

The outer Lobby with its historic appointments and marble floor offer an impressive way to make a grand entrance and greet your guests in style.

The Gallery



The modern gallery designed by Spillman Farmer strikes a stark contrast to the historic detail of the theatre and ballroom and provides a complimentary backdrop for the rotating displays of local artists work.

The Gallery is a popular meeting place for members, patrons and sponsors before most State Theatre performances and during intermission.

Using portable staging and dance floor, the space is used for smaller concerts, classes and business meetings. Offering a private entrance off 5th Street, the Gallery will accommodate parties up to 120 seated and 200 standing without a dance floor.
